This month my article is about the duties of the Rules Committee. The Rules Committee is another one of the three (3) General Committees in a squadron. The members are elected, and the Commander is not a member of the Committee.

As per section 5.6 of our Squadron's Bylaws, the Rule Committee consists of a chairman and two (2) other members, one of whom shall be elected by the active members at the annual meeting each year for a term of three (3) years.

Section 6.9 of our squadron bylaws states: "The Rules

Committee shall be the guardian of adherence to the USPS by-laws, USPS policy, and squadron bylaws. The committee shall be familiar with the current edition of the 'Model Bylaws for Squadrons of USPS' and prepare recommendations as necessary to keep this squadron's bylaws consistent with USPS policy. It shall prepare the wording of amendments as may be directed by the BOD or the membership or proposed on its own initiative."

If you are a detail person and have a good memory, this committee may be for you.

The November Basic Boating class had three students attending; all 3 passed. Future scheduled Basic Boating classes are: January 15, 17 & 22, 2019; February 19, 21 & 26, 2019; and March 19, 21 & 26, 2019. The classes each month are not on consecutive nights due to classroom availability.

Due to a lack of an instructor, the Marine Communications class, scheduled to start 3 December, has been cancelled. Hopefully, I won't have to cancel other classes due to no instructors. Cruise Planning, scheduled for spring 2019, is in jeopardy with no instructor currently assigned. We need instructors!

Seamanship starts 10 December, taught by P/C Rick Wood, SN (please register by 26 November). This is the first course usually taken after the Basic Boating course.

**Palm Beach Sail & Power Squadron
Fall/Winter 2018-2019
Course Schedule**

Typically, this class includes on-the-water training in Commander One.

Advanced Piloting, 12 December with Instructor Lt Tom Collins, SN (please register by 28 November). Advanced Piloting builds on the skills learned in Piloting and continues to build coastal and inland navigation skills.

Let me share with you a vision of a possible future for USPS education that was discussed at the SEO meeting during the District 8 Fall Conference. The concept is called *blended learning* and consists of combining digital, direct, and hands-on learning. For example: Students will take an online class from USPS University. While taking the online class, they will have periodic discussion sessions with a local squadron mentor. These sessions could be in person, i.e. in a classroom, or via webinar or other digital format. They would also meet for hands-on and on-the-water training, as applicable. Keep in mind, this is only a possible distant future; there is no activity yet in USPS (at least as far as I know) to go there. It is intriguing,

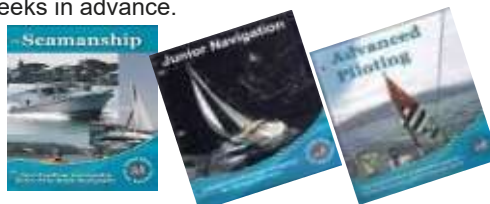

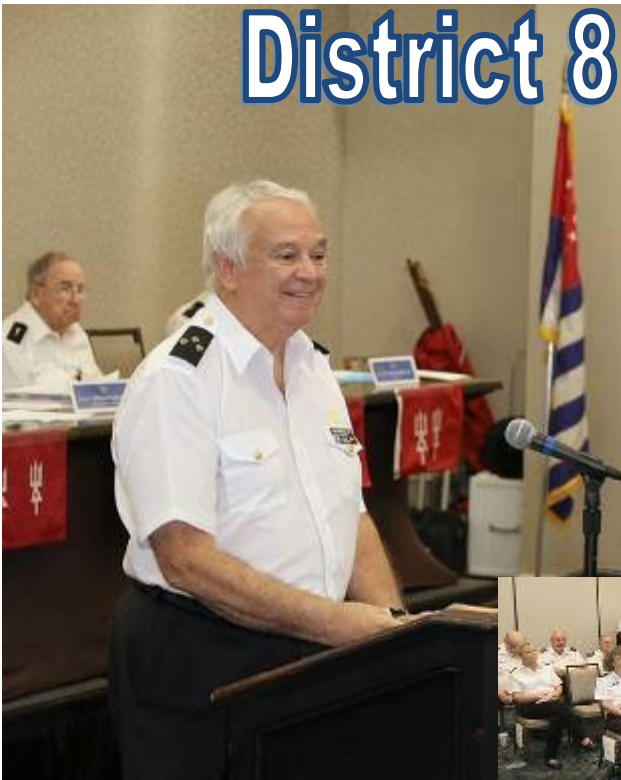

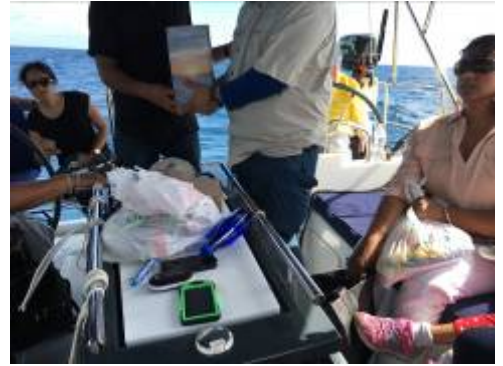
Callisto's Tips, Tricks, & Techniques for Sailors

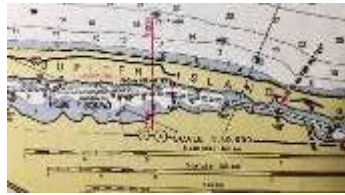

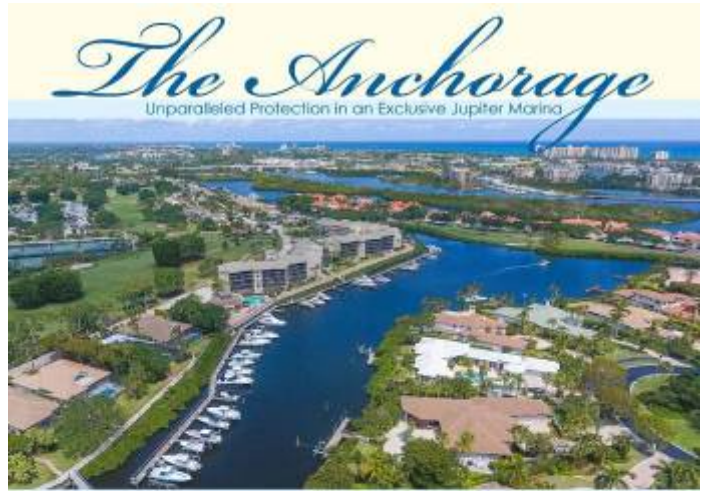
