ANCHORING



In our waters, be it the Indian River or the Banana River, most of the time our biggest concern is not to let out too much scope to prevent interference with the swing of neighboring anchored vessels. The bottom which can be sand, mud, occasional clay, or muck is not much of a worry other than cleaning the mess off the anchor as the gear comes back on board. In other words, most of the time anchoring around here is “duck soup.”

Weather is always a consideration once the wind gets over 15 mph from the NE, kicking up waves and whitecaps. Once the wind strength goes beyond that you need to develop a plan and prepare. If anchoring is a consideration, anchoring under truly adverse conditions requires additional skills and gear. To learn more about anchoring in challenging weather, attend our February 15 meeting for a discussion of Hurricane Matthew and what two of our members endured on a 41 ft sloop (i.e. Murphy’s Law: Seldom does only one thing go wrong).

Another potential problem when anchoring – usually the result of carelessness – is snagging something like your neighbor’s rode, bottom debris, or a submerged cable or pipe (look around and consult your chart). Years ago, we anchored our chartered houseboat in the Everglades. The chart showed no rocks or marine cables; however, our gear refused to come up, we suspected a tree trunk that got in the way. Overriding the anchor multiple times at varying angles for over half an hour finally got us off, just as I was on the verge of invoking skipper’s privilege and delegating a volunteer to go for a dive and retrieval.

There are several means of releasing a stuck anchor, all discussed in our basic boating classes. A novel approach is with the use of a device described and demonstrated in the following video links: <https://youtu.be/7HEh3cKywYc> and <https://youtu.be/SahVAAQHAzQ>

Lastly, as a boat owner, keep your anchoring gear in tip-top shape because it is connected to probably your second largest investment – your boat. Have a plan in case the unexpected hits you, know the conditions of the sea bottom, and stay on top of the weather forecast. (One more Murphy’s law: Things always go wrong at the most inopportune time and when you least expect them).

Take Advantage of ABC-SB!



In thinking back over my many years of USPS membership, my thoughts go back to the 12-week USPS Basic Boating course which was offered back in the middle 1950s. I remember as a new boater, with no boating background, both the book knowledge as well as the personal experiences of the USPS instructors. Upon completing the course and passing the examination, students came away with a great deal of valuable boating information. Among the items we were taught over and over was the list of USCG required equipment along with other things which the instructors thought we should have on our boat, i.e. radio, charts, anchor with enough anchor rode, etc. Upon the course completion I joined our local area squadron, Captree Power Squadron on the south shore of Long Island.

A few years later at one of our squadron rendezvous, several of our members were gathered around one of the picnic tables discussing boat travel to the eastern end of Long Island. We were interrupted by a person who happened by and who was not a squadron member. He said he had overheard our discussion regarding the eastern end of L.I. and asked if we could assist him. Seems he was planning a similar trip but had no knowledge of the route. We advised him to bring us his chart and we would lay out the courses for him. He left us and reappeared a few minutes later with his chart in hand. Chart? He appeared with a **placemat** of Long Island that he said was his only chart. Of course this was unacceptable, and we showed him a copy of the USCG chart covering the route he was asking about. My thought immediately went back to sitting in the 12-week Basic Boating class and the sessions on charts. We then suggested he take the USPS Basic Boating course before taking any future boating trips. He was very grateful, and we did see him sign up for our next Basic Boating course.

Having the proper maritime equipment on board one's boat and knowing how to use these items still prove the value of USPS membership. The various USPS Educational courses cover just about all aspects of boating. And over the years I have seen the up-grades to each of these courses meet the ever changing needs of today's boater. During my 55 years of USPS membership, I have taken all the USPS Educational courses, even knowing that I might not have a need for some of them, but better to have the knowledge than not.

As a member of America's Boating Club of South Brevard, why not take advantage of our very talented instructors and avail yourself of some of the Educational opportunities. You may never know when you might need the information or be able to assist someone else seeking said knowledge.

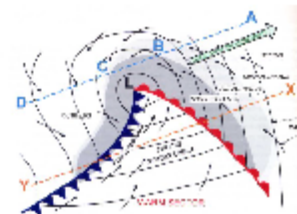

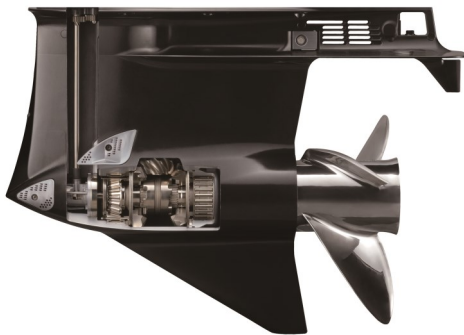
ENGINE MAINTENANCE SEMINARS RESCHEDULED

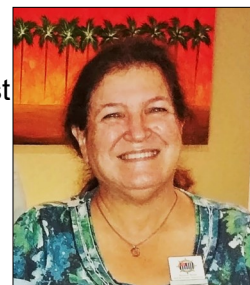
A virtual D23 Winter Council Mtg was held

Boat Parade

170 boats participated in the Boat Parade in 2020. This is a very large increase over previous years (70-80 last year). We are not sure why.

Bob Moore volunteered to generate a SurveyMonkey survey to see if he can determine the change in attendance. He would also like to contact bars and restaurants in the area which might help sponsor the event and broadcast the LIVE parade video at their business. He also suggested that he can pick up the camera feed of the Boat Parade and put it on his feed. He suggested he work with the Squadron's PRO. Ernst will contact Nancy Layton to see if she would be interested in being the Squadron's PRO. Bob Moore also suggested that we use the website called "Next Door" to add our events to get more notice.

Last year 40 people accessed the online video of the Boat Parade. This year, over 100 people accessed the video.

We would like to offer Valerie Dietrich, Bill Giers, and Bob Moore an honorary membership for 2021 based on their service to the Squadron. Wally Jones made this motion; seconded by Stephanie Murphy. Passed unanimously. Ernst will generate the certificates for them.

Awards (one \$150 award per category) will be given for Best Decorated Boat Contest: Judges determined best decorated boats based on pictures as well as visual inspection of 12 boats passing the Judges Boat during the Parade.

Old Business:

Holiday Party: Stephanie Murphy dropped off collected toys and Food Drive boxes at the South Brevard Sharing Center in Melbourne on the day after the Holiday Party.

Storage Unit: The storage unit will be retained due to the amount of large items which have to be stored for the Squadron. Two planned cleanup dates are tentatively set for February 13 and 20, 2021. Other locations used for storage will be consolidated into the Mini-Storage Unit. We will assess items no longer needed and get rid of items no longer serviceable. An inventory will be performed. John, Stephanie (from Shari), and Jim Merker have keys for the storage unit. Stephanie will bring some boxes, garbage bags, and a 2-wheel cart.

Cdr Merker asked everyone to think of fun events to hold this upcoming year so that we can all enjoy our boating friends.

The 2021 ABC-SB Calendar was reviewed and events updated. We talked about having a Corn Roast in June and an Oktoberfest in October.

Flare-Ups will be scheduled for May and November.

Still open is our creating a membership level that would not require National Membership. We would like it to be an auxiliary or local level where members can participate in all Squadron activities, such as taking courses and receiving the newsletter.

It was decided to not participate in Samsons Island Open House this year. Shari will contact the Samsons Island POC and respectfully decline their offer.

Next Executive Committee meeting will be at 7:00pm on **February 6**, 2021 via Go To Meeting.

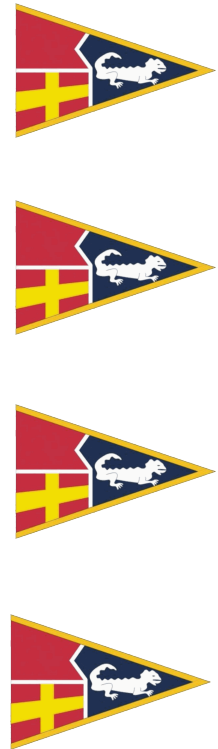

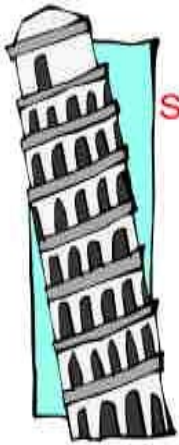

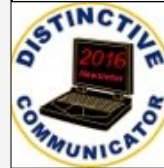
