



MEMBERSHIP

I am sure you know that we are now within the Hurricane season which runs from I June until 30 November. **DO YOU HAVE A HURRICANE PLAN FOR YOUR BOAT?** Here are some of the ways to prepare for such an event.



Have a Plan

Preparation for a hurricane begins with having a PLAN. Start with the following:

- Know the hurricane policies of your marina
- Take action 48-72 hours prior to the storm's arrival
- Remove and store items that can be removed
- · Test your plan for shortcomings

Be Prepared

Essential items following a hurricane warning go fast. i.e. duct tape, dock lines, fenders and other items to batten down your hatches.

Monitor the Weather

Stay alert for weather bulletins and be ready to act on short notice.

Safe Location

Move your boat to a safe location if possible.

Stuck in the Same Marina

If your boat can't be removed from the water, ask if it can be relocated to a larger slip. A boat centered in an oversized slip with long lines at shallow angles to the boat will be able to rise and fall with a storm surge and has less chance of chafing against the sides of the slip.

Insurance

If you carry marine insurance get out the policy and review its contents. There may be important conditions which could affect any hurricane damage payment.

Ask a Friend

If you have never experienced a hurricane, seek out other boaters at your marina and ask what they did during a hurricane. Experience many times is better than the written word.





Man Overboard Rescue Training was held on 22 May and was a great success. Cdr Merker, Tinker & Stephanie Murphy launched at 9 a.m., dropped buoys and talked to each participant. The session started at 10 a.m. Participants I ncluded the Melbourne Police Department Patrol Boat, Melbourne Fire Department Patrol Boat, and members Monika & Joe Bradley and Shari Marshall & Wally Jones. With that success, we told the Melbourne PD Brian Smith that another MOB session would be held on Saturday 21 August followed by a lunch at a local restaurant for those who would like to participate.
